Geiger, who is currently an assistant scoutmaster in Troop 50, chartered by the Auburn Rotary Club, earned 21 merit badges in his effort to achieve Boy Scouting's highest rank — including First Aid Merit Badge, which he credits as preparing him for a career in the medical field and serving as “the first step in helping me achieve this goal.” For his Eagle Scout leadership service project, he and volunteers collectively logged 227 hours building an informational kiosk at the Opelika Wood Duck Heritage Preserve and Siddique Nature Park.
